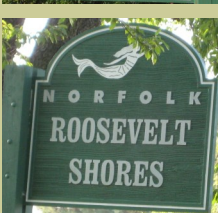

## From the President

Dear Neighbors,

This month we offer you the opportunity to help save a life with simple instruction from our Norfolk Fire-Rescue family. This very informal program will help bring you confidence in the event you have to save someone's life. This "Hands Only CPR" class is designed for the layman, so that chest compressions will keep oxygen flowing until the first responders arrive; there is no mouth-to-mouth. Stations will be set up in our building for you to have a one-on-one training session with the instructors. This event is open to anyone, no matter where they live and we'll start at 6:30pm.

## Garbage & Recycling Collection

- Our neighborhood's regular collection day is Wednesday. Recycling is collected every other Wednesday
- Household trash, recycling, bulk waste, yard waste and tires are all collected at the curb.
- Up to four tires per household per month will be accepted at no charge for collection.
- Items may be taken to the curb beginning at 5 p.m. the day before collection and no later than 7 a.m.
- Place carts six feet from vehicles, poles and other obstructions.
- Cart lids should be closed. If garbage doesn't fit inside the can, you must request a bulk waste collection. These must be called in to (757) 664-6510, emailed to [healthyneighborhoods@norfolk.gov](mailto:healthyneighborhoods@norfolk.gov) or submitted online at [www.norfolk.gov](http://www.norfolk.gov) before 3 p.m. Tuesday (the day before our scheduled collection).
- Yard waste is collected the same day as garbage and should be in clear plastic bags or a 30 gallon container. Up to 20 clear bags or 20 bundles of yard waste is acceptable per collection.
