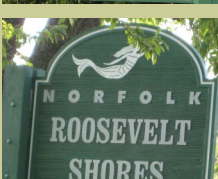
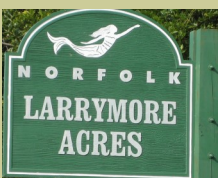

## Protect Your Pipes

Winter is upon us and frozen and burst water pipes can do serious damage to your home and wallet. Use the following tips to protect your plumbing from cold temperatures.

- Drain and disconnect all outdoor hoses
- Insulate pipes in unheated areas, such as garages, attics and crawl spaces
- Let water drip from faucets during extremely cold temperatures to prevent pipes from freezing
- Install heat tape or heat cable on exposed water pipes or pipes located in areas where the temperature may fall below freezing
- Seal off vents, doors, windows and cracks. Open cabinets and doors to allow heat to reach covered pipes
- Find the master shutoff valve. Shutting off the master water valve can help prevent additional water damage to your home
- Don't forget — outdoor irrigation systems should be winterized to protect them from being damaged by freezing temperatures
