

City Launches New myNorfolk Mobile App and Online Resident Portal

Residents, businesses and visitors are now connected to the City of Norfolk like never before with a customized, data-driven, online experience that will allow them to submit service requests, find city information, and pay city bills with ease. Residents are able to see their concern through to closure as it moves throughout the process.

Protect Your Drains During Holiday Cooking

Keep your drains clog-free and healthy by practicing the following good-to-do methods:

- **CAN THE GREASE** – Put used cooking grease into an empty, heat-safe container, such as a soup can, and store it in the freezer. Once solidified, toss the can into the garbage.
- **SCRAPE THE PLATE** - Wipe all pots, pans, dishes and cooking utensils with a paper towel prior to washing to absorb the grease.
- **CATCH THE SCRAPS** - Eliminate using the garbage disposal. Catch food scraps in your sink with a basket or strainer and toss them into the trash.
- **RECYCLE** - Large quantities of used cooking oil can be recycled through Norfolk's household hazardous waste program.

Holiday Fire Safety Tips

The holiday season is upon us, which means more cooking, more decorating and more risk of fire emergencies. Here are a few tips on how to keep your home safe during the holidays!

- Keep decorations at least 3 feet from any open flame or heat source
- Discard decorations with frayed or pinched wires
- Never string together multiple extension cords or run cords under rugs
- Water Christmas trees daily and discard trees when they are dry and dropping needles
- Turn off space heaters when you leave the room
- Don't leave cooking unattended
- Make sure you have working smoke detectors. Norfolk Fire-Rescue will install smoke detectors free of charge. Call 664-6510 to request a smoke detector
